- 2 Click on **AcerSystem User Guide.**



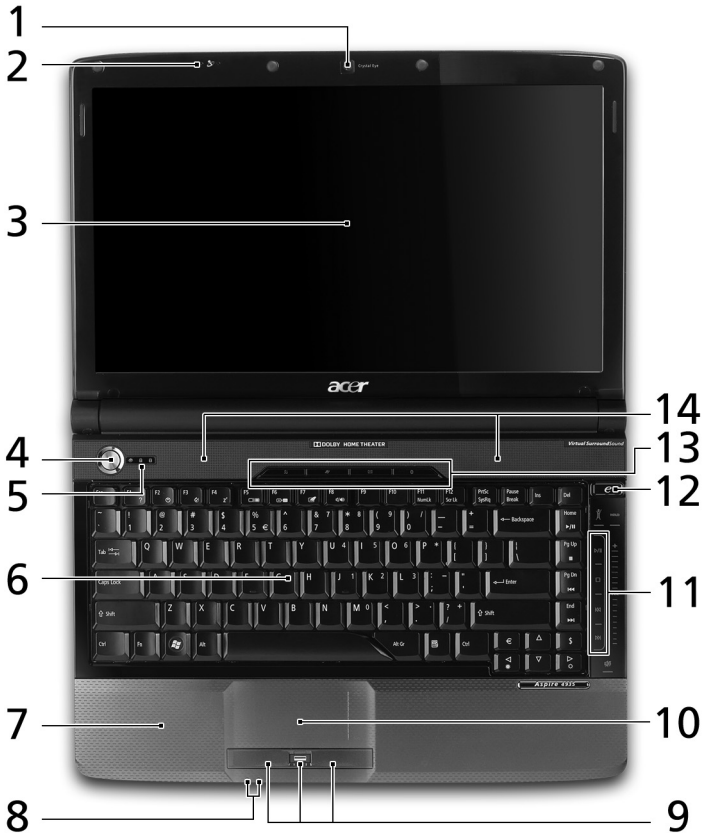

#	Icon	Item	Description
1		Acer Crystal Eye webcam	Web camera for video communication. (only for certain models)

#	Icon	Item	Description
2		Microphone	Internal microphone for sound recording.
3		Display screen	Also called Liquid-Crystal Display (LCD), displays computer output (Configuration may vary by models).
4		Power button	Turns the computer on and off.
5		Status indicators	Light-Emitting Diodes (LEDs) that light up to show the status of the computer's functions and components. Please refer to the <b>Generic User Guide</b> for more details.
6		Keyboard	For entering data into your computer.
7		Palmrest	Comfortable support area for your hands when you use the computer.
8		Status indicators	Light-Emitting Diodes (LEDs) that light up to show the status of the computer's functions and components. Please refer to the <b>Generic User Guide</b> for more details.
9		Click buttons (left, center* and right)	The left and right buttons function like the left and right mouse buttons. *The center button serves as Acer Bio-Protection fingerprint reader supporting Acer FingerNav 4-way control function (only for certain models).
10		Touchpad	Touch-sensitive pointing device which functions like a computer mouse.
11		Acer MediaTouch keys	For use with Acer Arcade and other media playing programs.
12		Easy-launch buttons	Buttons for launching frequently used programs. Please refer to the <b>Generic User Guide</b> for more details.
13		Empowering key	Launch Acer Empowering Technology
14		Speakers	Left and right speakers deliver stereo audio output.

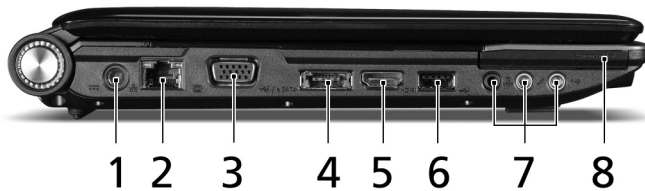

1		CIR receiver	Receives signals from a remote control.
2		6-in-1 card reader	Accepts Secure Digital (SD), MultiMediaCard (MMC), MultiMediaCard <sup>plus</sup> ™ (MMC <sup>plus</sup> ™), Memory Stick (MS), Memory Stick Pro (MS PRO), and xD-Picture Card. <b>Note:</b> Push to remove/install the card. Only one card can operate at any given time.











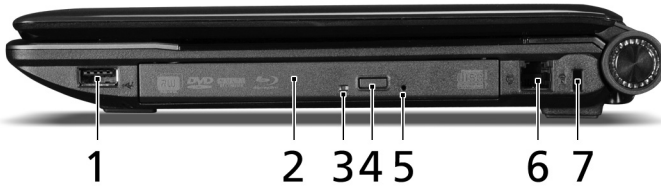

#	Icon	Item	Description
1		DC-in jack	Connects to an AC adapter.
2		Ethernet (RJ-45) port	Connects to an Ethernet 10/100/1000-based network.
3		External display (VGA) port	Connects to a display device (e.g., external monitor, LCD projector).
4		USB 2.0 / eSATA port	Connects to USB 2.0 or eSATA devices (only for certain models). <b>Note:</b> If you plug an eSATA device you will have two USB ports available in the mean time.
5	HDMI	HDMI port	Supports high definition digital video connections (only for certain models).
6		USB 2.0 port	Connects to USB 2.0 devices (e.g., USB mouse, USB camera).
7		Headphones/speaker/line-out jack with SPDIF support	Connects to audio line-out devices (e.g., speakers, headphones).
		Microphone jack	Accepts inputs from external microphones.
		Line-in jack	Accepts audio line-in devices (e.g., audio CD player, stereo walkman, mp3 player)
8		ExpressCard/54 slot	Accepts one ExpressCard/54 module.

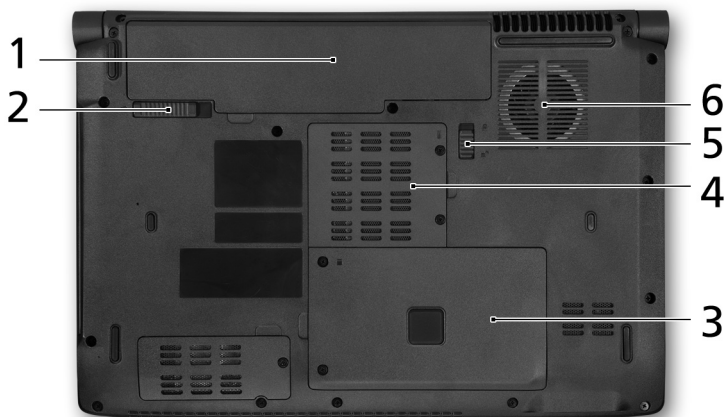

#	Icon	Item	Description
1		USB 2.0 port	Connects to USB 2.0 devices (e.g., USB mouse, USB camera).
2		Optical drive	Internal optical drive; accepts CDs or DVDs.
3		Optical disk access indicator	Lights up when the optical drive is active.
4		Optical drive eject button	Ejects the optical disk from the drive.
5		Emergency eject hole	Ejects the optical drive tray when the computer is turned off. <b>Note:</b> Insert a paper clip to the emergency eject hole to eject the optical drive tray when the computer is off.
6		Modem (RJ-11) port	Connects to a phone line.
7		Kensington lock slot	Connects to a Kensington-compatible computer security lock.

1		Battery bay	Houses the computer's battery pack.
2		Battery release latch	Releases the battery for removal.
3		Hard disk bay	Houses the computer's hard disk (secured with screws).
4		Memory compartment	Houses the computer's main memory.
5		Battery lock	Locks the battery in position.
6		Ventilation slots and cooling fan	Enable the computer to stay cool, even after prolonged use. <b>Note:</b> Do not cover or obstruct the opening of the fan.
